



Subject: 2010 Rebate Updates

On January 12, 2010, the Utah Public Service Commission approved ThermWise programs for 2010. The highlights of significant program changes are shown below. For complete program descriptions and requirements visit ThermWise.com.

- **Attic insulation tiered rebate changes effective January 1, 2010**

For existing home attic insulation projects, to qualify for a rebate customers must meet the requirements listed below.

1. Existing insulation level is greater than or equal to R-19; install an additional level greater than or equal to R-19 of new insulation achieving a total minimum level of insulation greater than or equal to R-38 and not exceeding a level of R-60. Qualifying new insulation will be paid at \$.20 per square foot.

OR, if applicable
 2. Existing insulation level less than R-19, meet the requirements of number 1 above and install an additional level greater than or equal to R-11 of new insulation achieving a total minimum of R-38 and not to exceed R-60. Qualifying new insulation for this tier will be paid at \$.07 per square foot.
- Existing home attic insulation and floor insulation projects will only qualify for one rebate per structure/premise for the life of that structure/premise.
 - Multifamily Duct Sealing requires an approved contractor to PTCS levels qualify for a \$125 rebate per unit.
 - Multifamily Duct Insulation requires an install to R-6 or higher and qualify for a \$150 rebate per unit.
 - An additional tier has been added for ENERGY STAR Natural Gas Storage Water Heaters with an EF of .67 or higher qualifies for a \$100 rebate.

Changes to the 2010 program rebates are effective starting January 1, 2010. Installations completed or purchases made prior to February 1, 2010 may be eligible under 2009 program requirement instead of 2010 requirements. To assist in timely rebate processing, please consider the following:

- On customer invoices, document the actual date of the purchase and installation. Verifications may be conducted to confirm the date of installation with customers. ***Inaccurate dates or applications not containing the installation dates will be rejected.***
