

ThermWise Builder Rebates

Tips for Home Builders

The ThermWise rebate process can be simplified with the following tips for collecting and maintaining information systems to ensure the required documentation is readily available.

Planning for ThermWise

Tip: Consult a Home Energy Rater at the planning stages of your new homes to understand ENERGY STAR® new home specifications. They will review your current building practices and help you incorporate any necessary changes into your building process. A list of Raters is posted on ThermWise.com.

Tip: Upgrade your furnaces and water heaters. Customers will appreciate saving money over the life of the appliance with operating costs. Talk with your heating and plumbing suppliers and contractors about equipment options meeting ThermWise rebate specifications. Lists of qualifying models are posted on ThermWise.com.

Getting Organized

Tip: Coordinate your team. Call a meeting with key staff members responsible for aspects of the ThermWise rebate process. Define your process. Track and share with your team ThermWise accomplishments.

Tip: Develop a simple ThermWise Rebates filing system that works for your company. One easy way is to organize files by home site address. Create a folder for each home upon receiving the partially completed ThermWise Builder Rebates Application and Questar Gas Service Line Agreement. Then add invoices, certificates, and reports as they become available.

Collecting Documentation for ThermWise equipment and ENERGY STAR homes

Tip: Ask your heating and plumbing suppliers to include model AND serial numbers in their invoices.

Tip: Collect model and serial numbers during final walk-through prior to closing or through your home warranty department.

Tip: Work with your Home Energy Rater to get the ENERGY STAR certificate and required Verification Summary Reports.

Tip: If you're building ENERGY STAR homes AND including furnaces and water heaters meeting ThermWise requirements, each of your homes may be eligible for multiple rebates. Ask your Rater to run and provide additional modeling reports to ensure you're taking advantage of all rebates possible. For example, an ENERGY STAR home with two furnaces and two tankless water heaters meeting ThermWise specifications could be eligible for up to \$1,700 — \$500 (ENERGY STAR whole house) + \$600 (two 90 AFUE furnaces @ \$300 each) + \$600 (two tankless EF 0.80 water heaters @ \$300 each) = \$1,700.

Compiling and Submitting ThermWise Applications

Tip: To expedite the processing of your rebates, be sure to provide all of the required documentation. Carefully read page 2 of the ThermWise Builder Rebates Application for details. Just staple all documentation to your completed application, and mail it to:
